- Proposal for GMD qualifiers for videogames.
 - Proposal: Change the 245 subfield h GMD qualifier to the videogame platform.
 - Motioned by Jane Levine (WNK)
 - Seconded by Jeff Ahrens (RLK)
 - Motion passed by unanimous vote.
 - Draft list of GMD qualifiers:
 - Wii
 - PlayStation
 - PlayStation 2
 - PlayStation 3
 - Xbox
 - Xbox 360
 - GameCube
- ☐ Handling digital discs that are added to DVDs.
 - Background
 - Coming now with some new DVDs
 - Some added to a packaged DVD (rubberbanded together)
 - Some are part of the packaged item (legitimate from publisher)
 - Some are mentioned on the packaging, but not part of the original packaging
 - Most carry an expiration date and need a code to download
 - o In OCLC, may or may not be mentioned in the catalog record

- When present, add a 500 note "Accompanying material may vary" to catalog record.
- If choose to circulate, make some mention of what the second item is in the catalog record.
- If choose not to circulate, add a public note to the item record.

 - Can do as an add-on, where your searches start in your local catalog and then go into WorldCat.
