1. Circulation and ILL Online Training Kit (30 mins)

3. EXEMPT Patron Code Usage (30 mins)

- a. Libraries have access to an EXEMPT patron code for users who may be exempt from fines or have higher checkout limits, such as staff personal use cards. Some libraries may have local policies that dictate these cards should only be used locally. In these cases, database checkout limits have been set up to restrict borrowing privileges at other locations. However, this can affect staff who are also residents of the library where they work.
- b. What is the group's recommendation for a best practice related to EXEMPT patron code cards?

ACTION: Discuss and determine best practice for EXEMPT patron code cards.
