### Partner Program

- CCS has signed on to be a development partner for Vega Discover (catalog interface)
- As development partners, we'll:
  - Participate in advisory discussions and usability testing
  - Beta test Vega
  - Share feedback with Innovative
  - If needs are met, adopt Vega Discover as replacement for PowerPAC in Spring 2022

# Phase 1: Project Planning & Kickoff

### CCS:

- Attend development partner meetings with iii
- Planning for Vega setup
- Build user testing strategy and plan
- Recruite beta libraries (May)
  - Assist with user testing and feedback gathering
  - Adopt Vega in library during soft launch

### **Governing Board:**

Discuss project plan and potential rollout options (April)

### Phase 2: Vega Soft Launch

#### CCS:

- Coordinate launch of Vega instance
- Provide training opportunities and documentation
- Test & troubleshoot bugs, issues, etc.
- Complete user testing

#### **Beta Libraries**

- Begin using Vega in library
- Assist with gathering patron feedback
- Recruit patrons for usability testing

### **Governing Board:**

• Discusses criteria for Vega acceptance at October meeting

## Phase 3: General Availability and Go Live

### CCS:

- Participate in ongoing testing and development
- Additional user testing and feedback gathering as needed
- Compile user testing data into recommendation for Governing Board
- Coordinate additional training for members

### **Governing Board:**

- Vote on whether to accept Vega as primary discovery solution (January 2022)
- Pending GB approval and preferred rollout plan, CCS libraries switch over to Vega Discover (March 2022)
