THE NEXT GROUP OF BIBLIOGRAPHIC RECORDS WILL BE GOING TO MARCIVE SOON

- Bibliographic records will probably be sent next Wednesday, May 26th
- There will be approximately 12,500 of them
- Want them sent before the “Illegal aliens” changes are done
- Will be in contact with Marcive, so in future batches, they will not undo any of those types of changes

NEW SUBJECT HEADINGS WORTHY OF NOTE:

- New subject headings that have bibliographic records attached include:
 - Drag queens
 - Drag kings
 - Women hikers
 - Outdoorswoman
 - Racism in criminal justice administration

NEW SUBJECT HEADING THAT STILL NEEDS RETROSPECTIVE WORK DONE:

- Rail passengers

NEW GENRE HEADINGS FROM LC LIST #3:

- Africanfuturistic fiction
- Psychological films

YOUNG ADULT FICTION:

- For the genre heading of “Young adult fiction”
- Please use “655 _7 Young adult fiction. \$2local

ONE MORE SUBJECT HEADING REMINDER:

- The subject heading of “Extraterrestrial beings” should be used for material on Outer Space and the beings that live there.
- Do NOT use the term “Aliens”
- Rachel has done some cleanup with this subject heading

SUBDIVISION OF BIOGRAPHY:

- Do not use the subdivision of “biography” for any personal subject heading, except those that have an explicit subject heading for the person in the national authority file.

Examples include:

- Shakespeare, William, 1564-1616.
- Jesus Christ
- Muhammad, Prophet, -632
- Mary, Blessed Virgin, Saint

DO NOT CONSIDER THESE AS SERIES:

- Heading like: Schwab,Victoria. \$t City of ghost. \$s Spoken word (Buhr)
- These are not series but do have authority records added
- This is because under RDA they are considered expressions.
- Treat them as an added entry (with a 700), but not as a series

OTHER MISCELLANEOUS NOTES:

- I am also deduping Grayslake and Palatine bibliographic records and concentrating on videos. Still, there are many to go, but a big chunk has already been done.
- I will be doing the changes to the records with “Illegal aliens”, etc. during the week of June 7th. The system will be doing the bulk of the changes (hopefully), but it will take me 3-4 days to finish the changes.
- Tickets sent to me during that time (and the week before) will take longer for me to reply, especially since I will also be returning from a week off.
