## Staff Reports

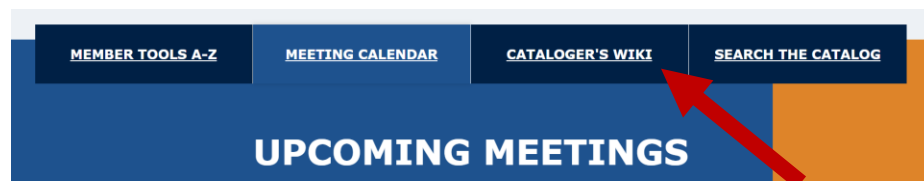

- **7.1 Upgrade:** The training server has been upgraded to Polaris 7.1. Information on the new features can be found in the [What's New in Polaris and Leap 7.1](#) document. New features in Polaris 7.1 include:

- Printing spine labels in Leap
- Ability to view and edit serials holdings records in Leap
- Ability to create fiscal year records, fund records, and supplier records in Leap
- Ordering and invoicing functionality for EDI orders in Leap

I will begin working on an Acquisitions in Leap online course and will lead two Acquisitions in Leap training courses in April. Additional serials training will be offered when the 7.2 upgrade is available.

- **OCLC Holdings:** OCLC recently contacted libraries about a [holdings update project](#). Libraries do not need to act on this. Although CCS updates holdings monthly for all libraries using OHM, an application created by SWAN, the holdings update project will help CCS to delete inaccurate holdings that were not properly deleted. CCS is working with other Illinois consortia and OCLC to complete this work, because we need to coordinate the project with SWAN. Illinois consortia had a meeting with OCLC on February 18th to discuss the project. I will update you when we have a date for the completion of the project.
- **Cataloger's Wiki:** The Cataloger's Wiki has been migrated to our new website server and updated to the latest version of the Wiki software. All pages on the [Cataloger's Wiki are now up-to-date](#). The Wiki can be easily accessed from a link on the CCS Homepage, just above Upcoming Meetings.



- **Immigration Subject Headings** page: The guidelines have been updated to include the recent Library of Congress update to change the illegal aliens related headings. It now includes guidelines for applying a Spanish subject heading to Spanish language materials.

- **Deduplication:** CCS Staff have completed the deduplication of records that can be easily identified. I've created record sets of records for individual libraries to review and deduplicate on their own time. I'd like to thank the volunteers that have taken time to help us deduplicate the catalog over the last two years.

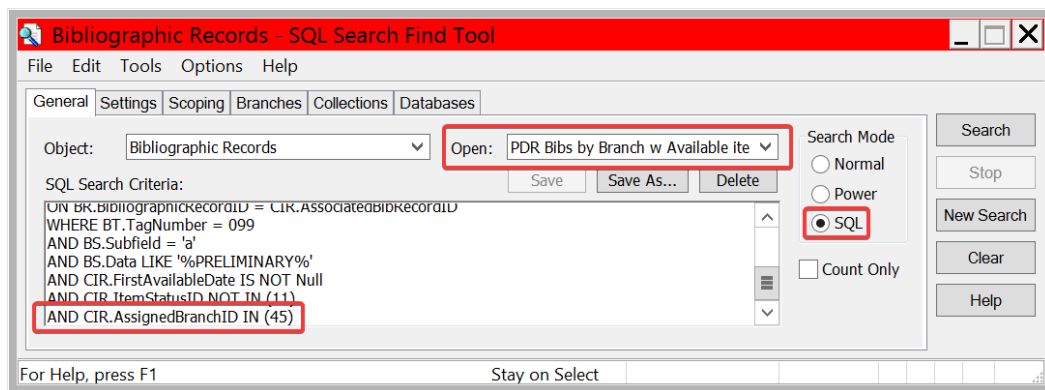
