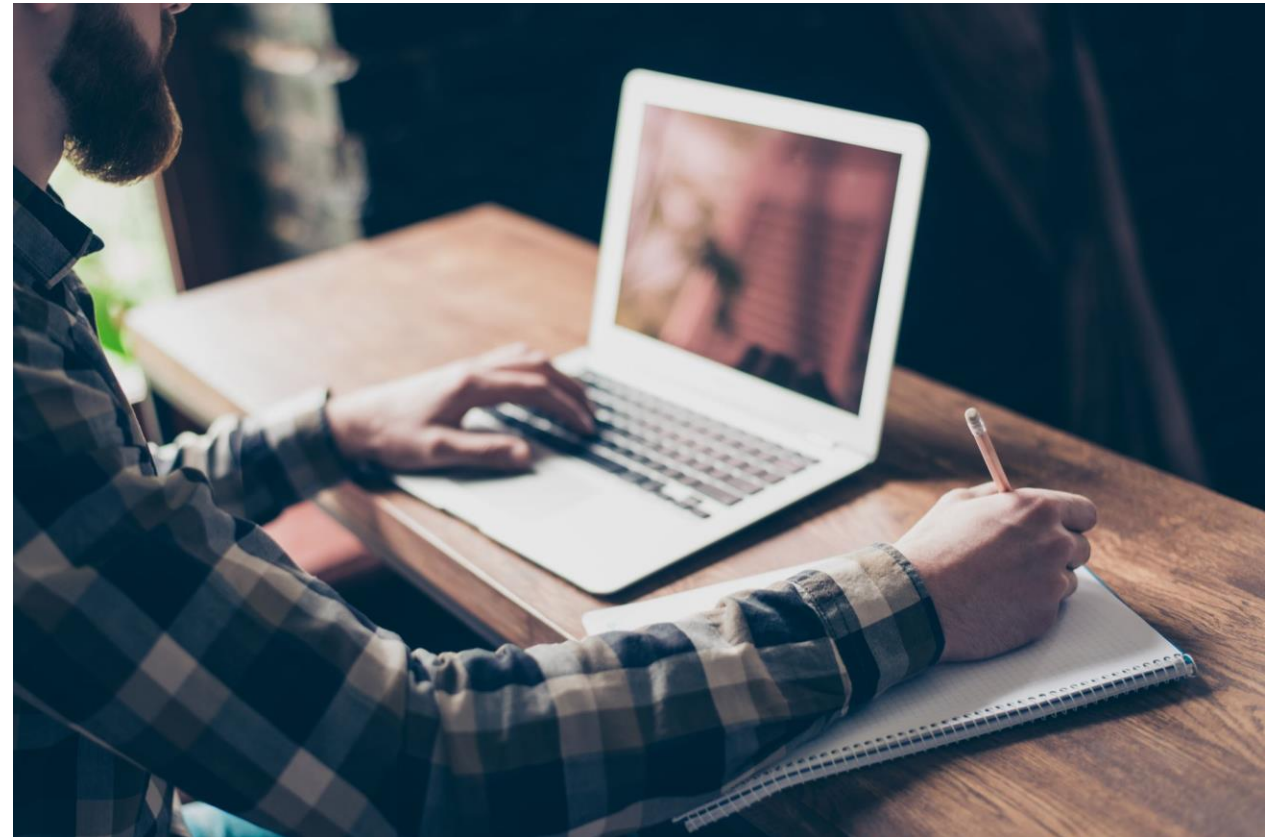
Call to Order

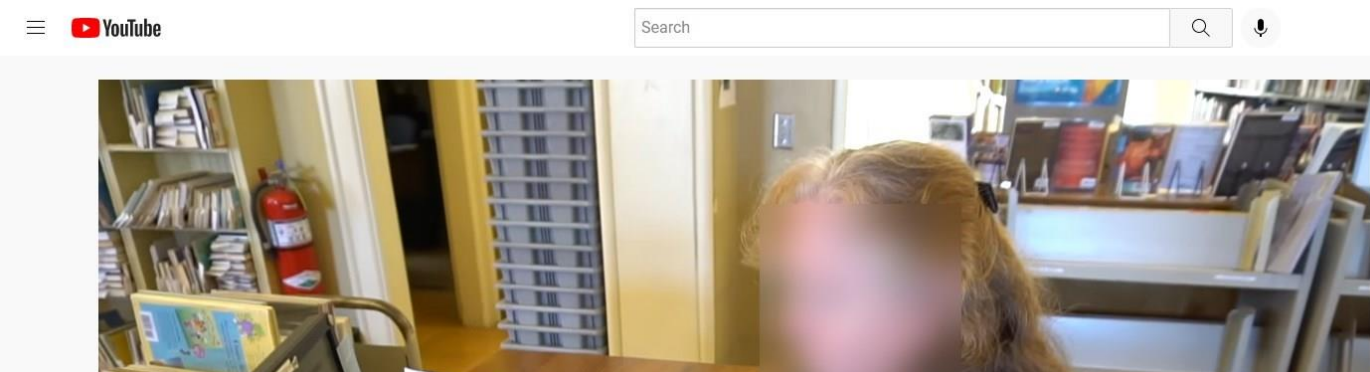

 - Activists believe they are testing their constitutional right and promotion free and open government



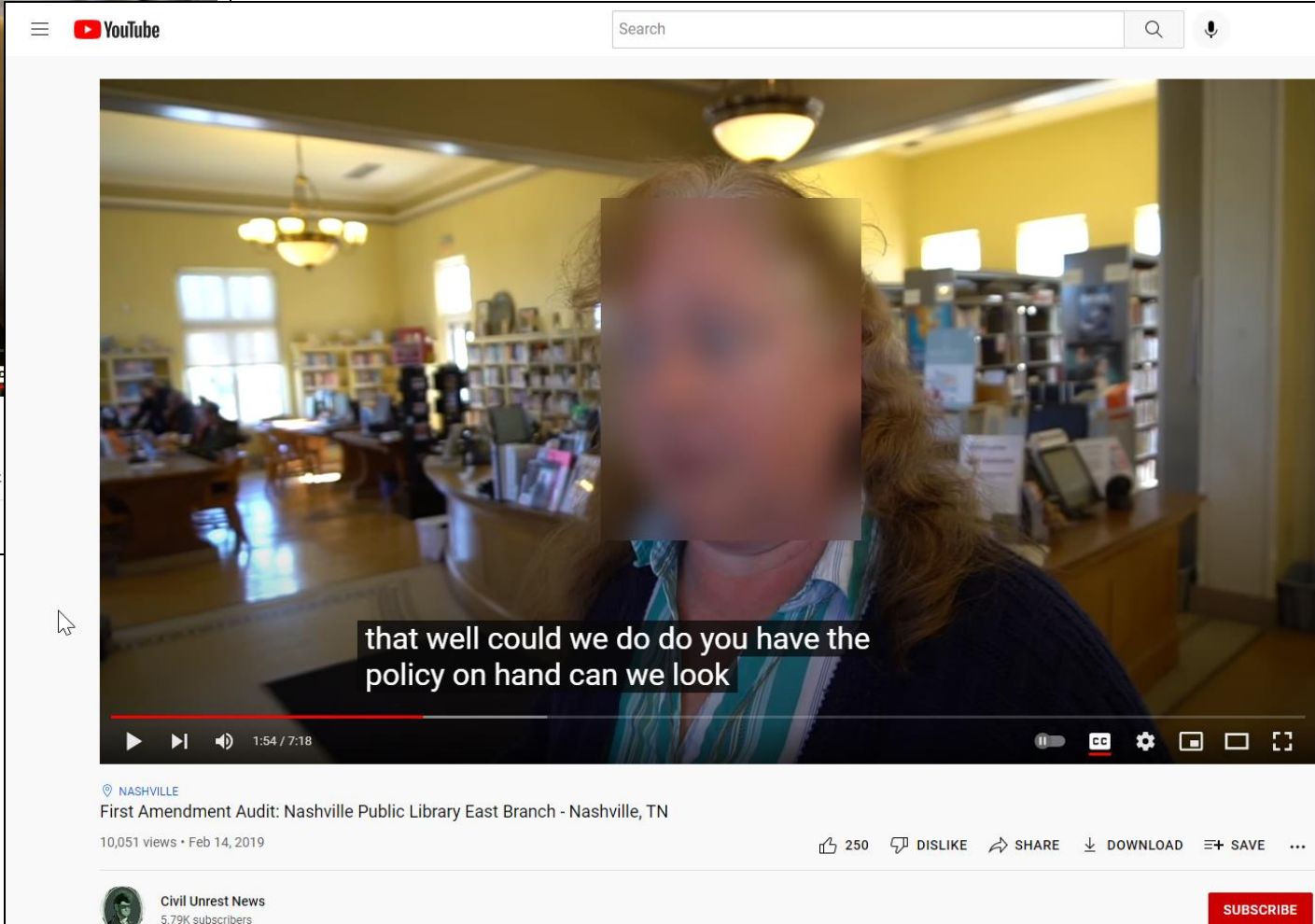

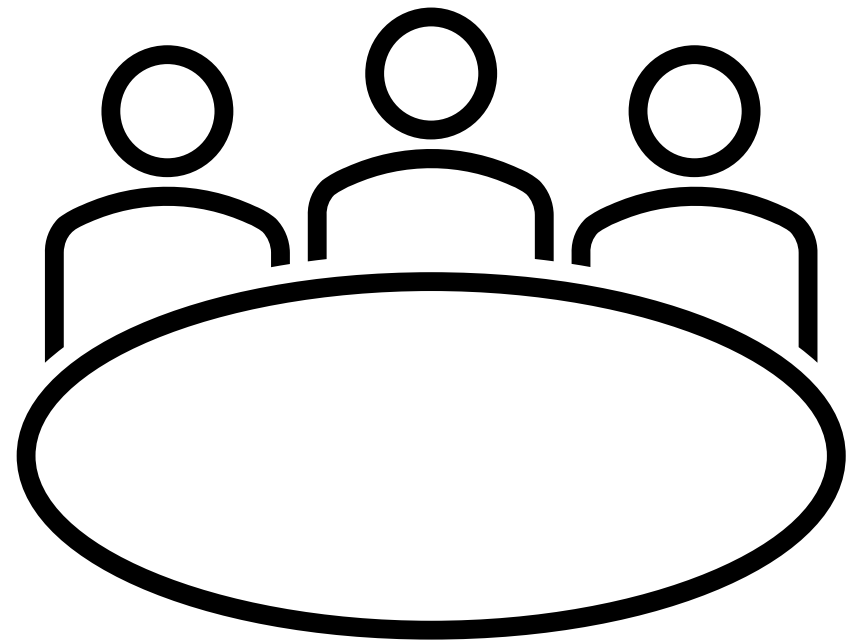
