1. Introductions (15 min.)

Discussion – Should the Core standards in the <u>Chart</u> include LC-PCC policy statements or OCLC statements?

Discussion of document: R. Fischer provided an overview of the project to review the bibliographic input standards page. She explained her recommended revision of the Unique Local Materials section of the page. SCRAP members provided suggestions on how to improve the statement on Unique Local Materials. R. Fischer provided an overview of the options for updating the chart on the page. SCRAP members discussed issues related to the new RDA Toolkit. SCRAP members will do research on the new RDA Toolkit, LC-PCC Policy statements, and OCLC Standards for the next meeting.

c. <u>Genre/Form Headings</u> review (5 min.)
