## New Business

1. Local practice about height for creating new records
(15-20 min.)
Discussion: If height is more than 2 cm and it is the only difference, is a new record necessary?

Summary of Emails from CATS listserv:

- The 2 cm guideline for a major difference requiring a separate record comes from section A5c in Differences Between Changes Within : guidelines on when to create a new record. You can download a PDF of the document here: Differences between Changes within: Guidelines on When to Create a New Record (ala.org)
A5c. Dimensions. The following differences in dimensions not attributable to different measurement techniques, different foldings, local binding or trimming, or local pack[1]aging are MAJOR.
- Books, pamphlets, and printed sheets: any significant difference (more than 2 cm .). For example:
- 23 cm . vs. 25 cm . is MINOR
- 28 cm . vs. 34 cm . is MAJOR
- OCLC guidelines: $300 \$ \mathrm{c}$ "a difference of more than 2 cm that is not a result of local binding or trimming may justify a new record."
- Rule may be because the difference between the mass-market paperback and a trade paperback is usually around 3 cm .

2. Any other topics
