1. Introductions (5 min.)

Old Business

- CAMM requested additional information on the following issues. Does SCRAP want to continue to pursue the motions? What additional information can we provide to CAMM? (10-20 min.)
 - a. Potential Motion #2: Motion to allow "Youth literacy materials" as a local genre heading in the catalog with scope notes that it can be used in records for materials intended to teach how to read using phonics/science of reading/teaching concepts as opposed to content or reading level appropriate materials.

Background: SCRAP members requested feedback on this heading from PAS before they were willing to pass a motion to recommend it. The members were concerned it would be redundant. PAS is supportive of adding the genre heading, but agrees it needs to be tightly scoped in order to be applied effectively. Their suggestion is to apply it to materials intended to teach how to read using phonics/science of reading/teaching concepts as opposed to content or reading-level appropriate materials. This scope differs from the heading for Adult literacy materials which can be applied to reading-level appropriate materials.

CAMM opinion via the minutes: After a discussion about not being clear on, those present asked that the motion be sent back to SCRAP to find out if the intention was to add the genre "Youth literacy materials' as a local genre heading" to all Youth readers or only to materials for late-to-start reading instruction and not to readers, which may duplicate the information already in the subject fields.

b. **Potential Motion #3**: Motion to add "Mexico, Gulf of" and "Denali, Mount (Alaska)" to 691 fields.

Background:

- As noted above, the following changes have been made:
 - o Mexico, Gulf of was CHANGED to America, Gulf of
 - o Oil spills -- Mexico, Gulf of was CHANGED to Oil spills -- America, Gulf of
 - Drilling platforms -- Accidents -- Mexico, Gulf of was CHANGED to Drilling platforms - - Accidents -- America, Gulf of
 - o Denali, Mount. (Alaska) was CHANGED to McKinley, Mount (Alaska)
- Approved Monthly List 12 LCSH 2 (2025)
- This decision has been very controversial. Many people are against this change.
- Response from Judith P. Canaan: "PTCP acknowledges the communications that the Library has received in response to tentative monthly list 12 LCSH 2 (list 2412a). The Library of Congress defers to the United States Board on Geographic Names (BGN) for place names contained within our controlled vocabularies and classification. For more information, please see our Subject Headings Manual sheet H 690 Formulating Geographic Headings and visit the BGN webpage."
- Rebecca Malinowski asked SCRAP for their feedback on the a best practice to improve access with the consideration that any change may need to be changed back in the future.
- SCRAP felt it would make sense to add the new headings as 691 fields without changing the LCSH headings. This allows both headings to be used as access points. They didn't vote on a motion, but **Rebecca** said that CAMM can go ahead and vote on a motion.

CAMM opinion via the minutes: Motion is being sent back to SCRAP, as there was discussion about the fact that we don't modify other subjects, even though the publishers use the other term in titles, etc. (e.g., publishers use 'Myanmar' but LC has 'Burma' as the official term with 'Myanmar' as a see also). Also, there are SEE FORs in the official LC authority records.



5. Videogame format in 092: Should SCRAP consider passing a motion to standardize this field for videogames? (10 min. – 15 min.)

Background: The 092 tag is a local call number. It is used inconsistently and can appear in records because it was in the OCLC record. This appears in the call number column of the Find Tool results. It can be useful to identify which platform a record is for. This field does not appear in the PAC. This would be for staff benefit only.

Potential motion: Recommend to CAMM to standardize the usage of the 092 field for videogames. Note: One option to standardize this is using the same format as the $\frac{753}{4}$
